You hereby agree that this authorization shall be to evidence your agreement to the charge herein incurred, and to defend against any charge back. Further, you hereby agree that you will indemnify the Firm for any costs incurred by the Firm for costs associated with any stop payment, cancellation or charge back.

By signing below, you, the Client, agree that if this payment is for services not yet rendered, then the funds shall be placed in an Interest on Lawyer's Account (IOLTA) held by the Firm, and the interest thereon will go to the Vermont Bar Foundation.
